Dante Cucurullo. (Director of the Academy and chamber music groups.) Magna Cum Laude B.A. in Music from the Universidad Autonoma de Santo Domingo (UASD) and graduate from the Dominican Republic's National Conservatory of Music. Bold and daring in a conservative music environment, Dante Cucurullo has had a profound impact on contemporary music in Dominican Republic. A pioneering and widely acclaimed composer of electroacoustic music and scores for musical theater, Mr. Cucurullo is a pianist, percussionist, and one of our country's most respected music educators and conductors, who influenced in opening the doors of the National Conservatory of Music to avant garde and popular music. Mr. Cucurullo has been honored several times with the Talía de Plata for his remarkable musical theater scores, is a seven-time winner of the National Composition Prize José Reyes, and received the Cassandra Award for Classical music. among other national and international accolades. His career as music educator spans more than 40 years.

She studied also at the Royal Conservatory of Music in Madrid, Spain, and graduated with a B.A. in Music from the Universidad Autónoma de Santo Domingo.
